Congress: Protect Americans who need the most care.

As the House and Senate put together the final tax bill, Americans who have high health care costs face a serious risk of a big tax increase just because of their medical expenses.

But Congress can protect them if the final bill includes the Senate provision on medical expense deductions at 7.5% of income. Deducting large expenses like wheelchairs, prescription drugs and home care costs makes a huge difference to middle-class families.

We urge Congress to protect Americans who need care the most and keep the Senate provision on medical expense deductions.
