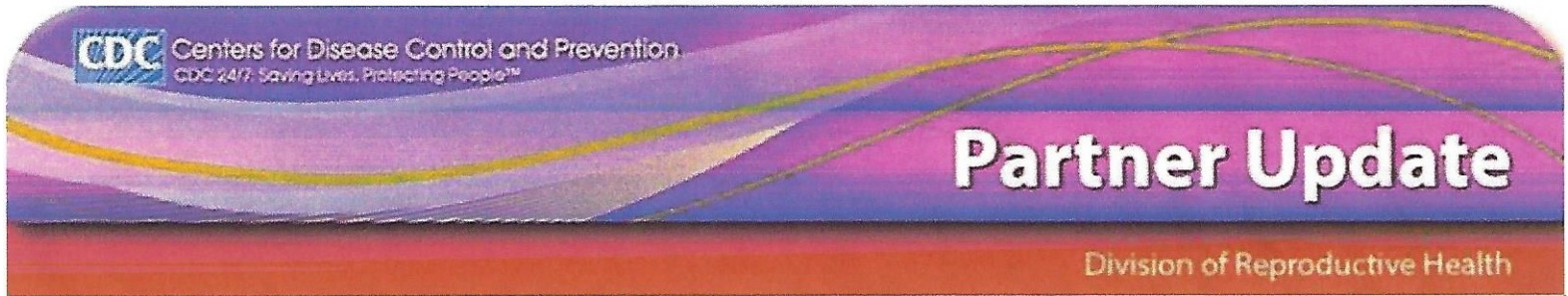

Dear DRH Partners,

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) is soliciting written comments on the proposed objectives for Healthy People 2030. This public comment period will allow you to provide feedback on the proposed HP2030 objectives, as well as the opportunity to put forward new Healthy People objectives.

In response to stakeholder input, Healthy People 2030 will be a [streamlined set of national health objectives](#) guiding the Nation in efforts to improve health. Healthy People 2030 will continue to represent critical public health priorities by addressing the leading causes of morbidity and mortality and driving action at the national, state, and local levels. Due to stakeholders' desire for a more specific and targeted initiative, many [current Healthy People 2020 objectives](#) will be discontinued. If you feel there are critical Healthy People 2020 objectives which are not represented in this streamlined approach, they can be proposed through the public comment process as new objectives.
