

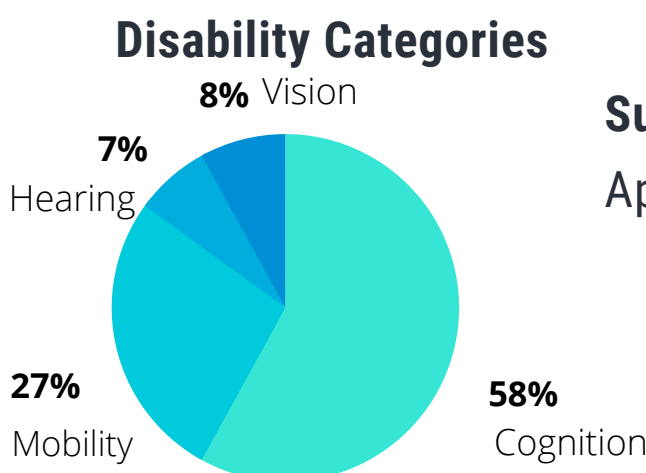


# AAHD COVID-19 & DISABILITY SURVEY

Key Findings on the effect of COVID-19 on people with Intellectual Disabilities, Autism, Epilepsy, or Brain Injury

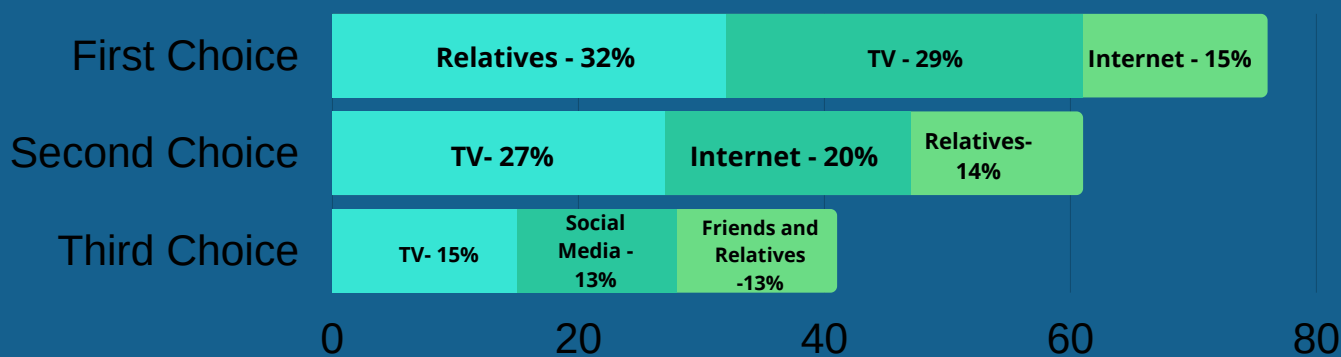
## RESEARCH APPROACH

April 17 - May 1, 2020

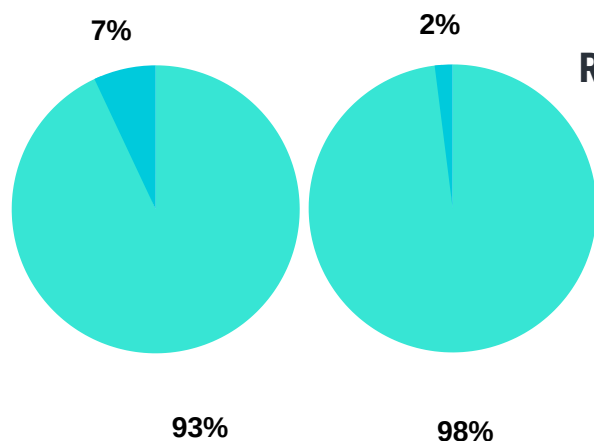
## KEY FINDINGS - SOURCES OF COVID-19 INFO

No (7%)

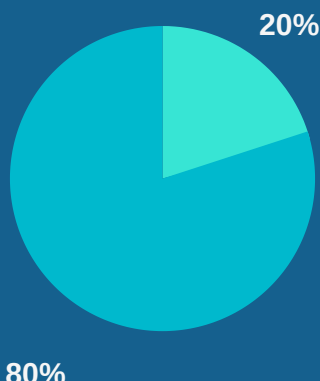


**Respondents who Received a Test**
