

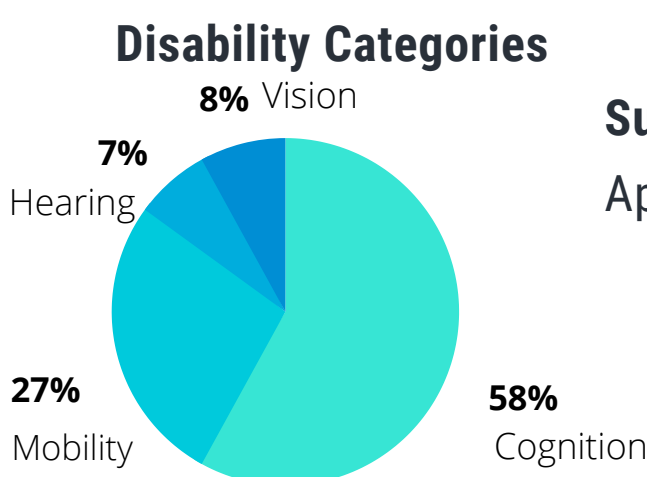

KEY FINDINGS - PERSONS WITH EMOTIONAL, PSYCHOLOGICAL, OR MENTAL HEALTH DISABILITIES

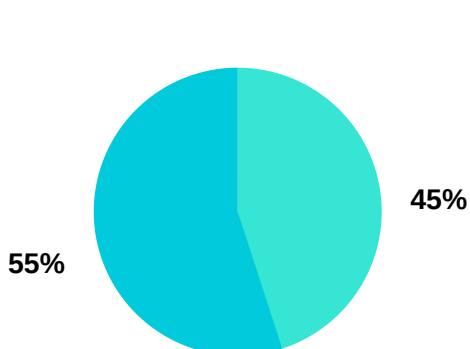
26% Respondents have a DCW



76% Respondents still receive DCW Services

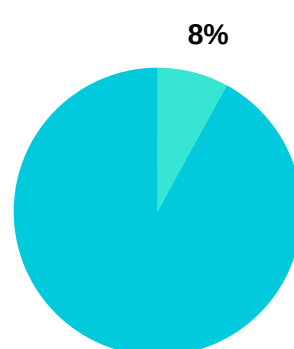


67% Respondents are unable to maintain a safe distance from their DCW

No Disruptions (45%)

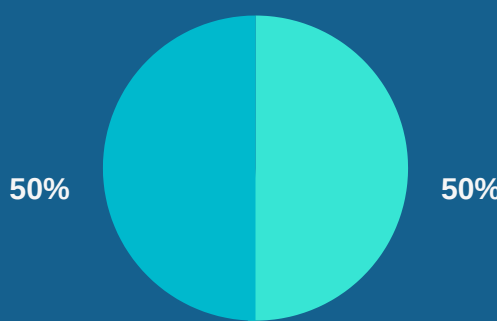


Respondents who Take Medications
