

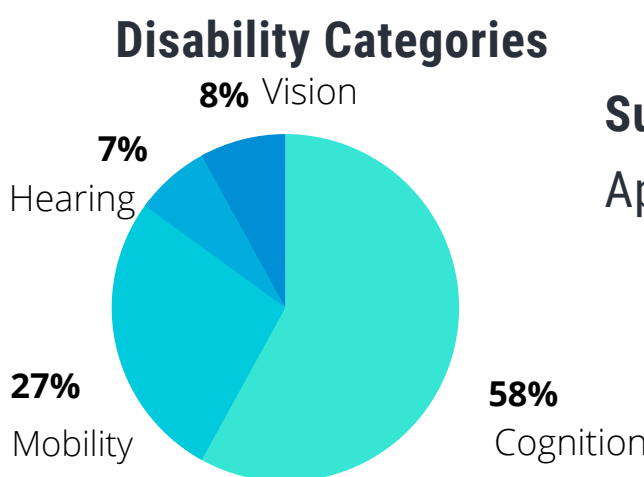

Key Findings on the effect of COVID-19 on persons with Emotional, Psychological, or Mental Health Disabilities.

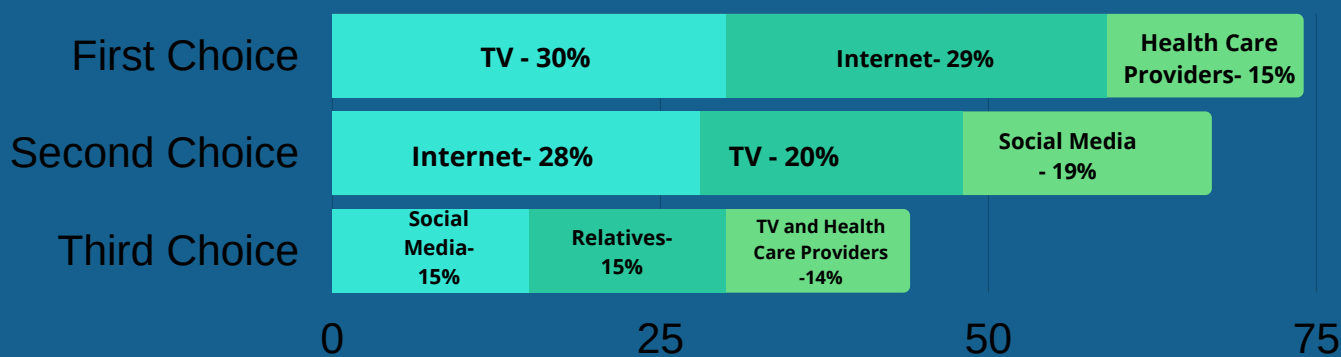
RESEARCH APPROACH

April 17 - May 1, 2020

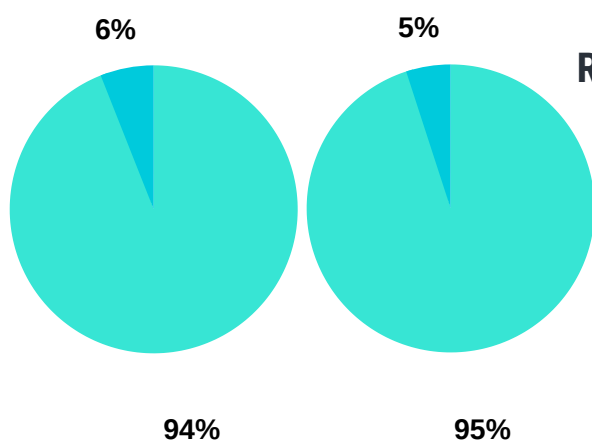
KEY FINDINGS - SOURCES OF COVID-19 INFO

No (6%)

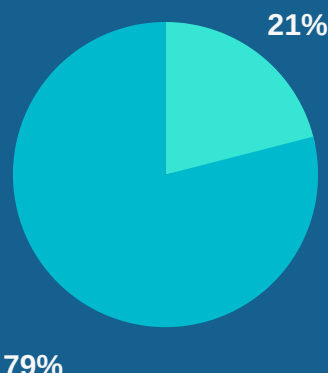


Respondents who Received a Test
