

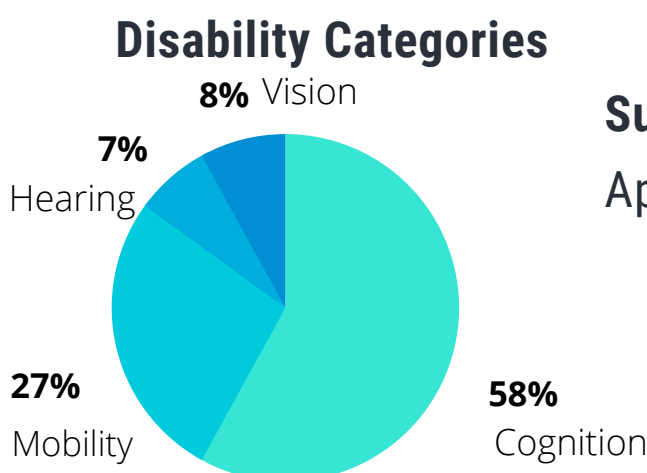

KEY FINDINGS - PERSONS WITH SERIOUS DIFFICULTY READING, WRITING, OR COMMUNICATING

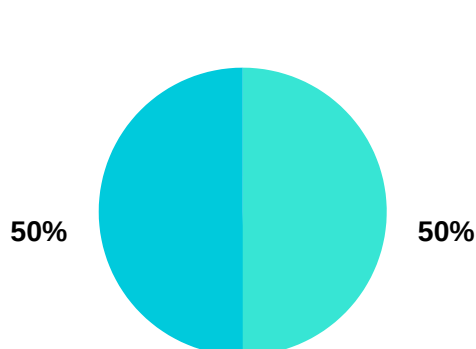
41% Respondents have a DCW



64% Respondents still receive DCW Services

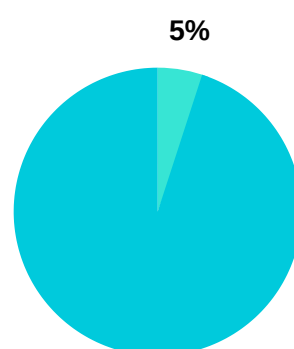


29% Respondents are unable to maintain a safe distance from their DCW

No Disruptions (50%)

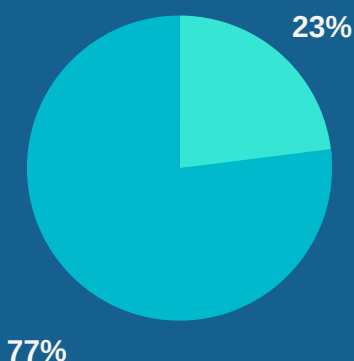


Respondents who Take Medications

NEW CHALLENGES
