

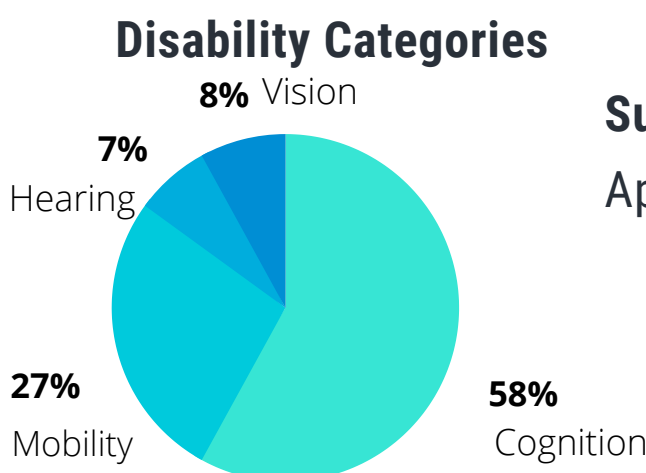


AAHD COVID-19 & DISABILITY SURVEY

KEY FINDINGS - DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING

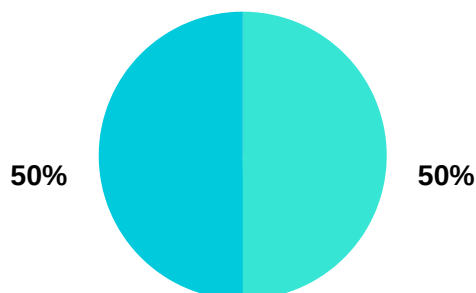
Only 13% Respondents have a DCW



81% Respondents still receive DCW Services

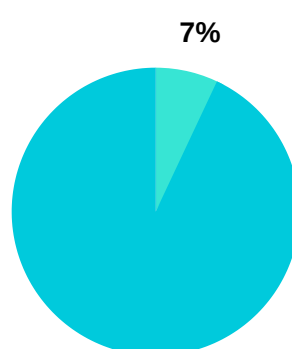


65% Respondents are unable to maintain a safe distance from their DCW
