

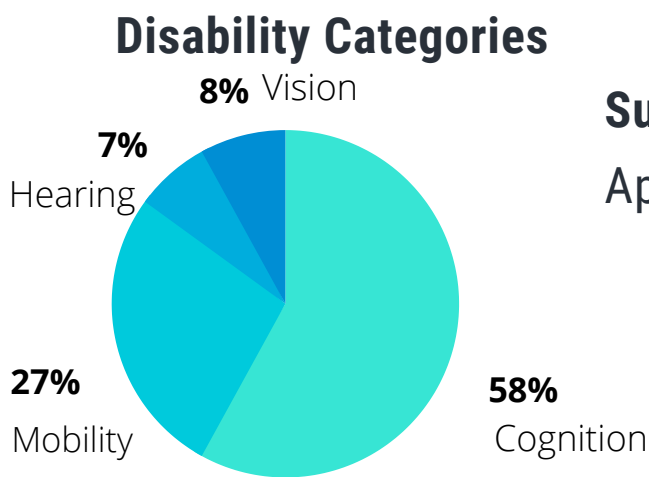


# AAHD COVID-19 & DISABILITY SURVEY

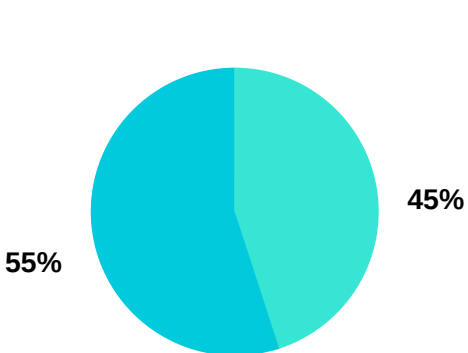
26% Respondents have a DCW



74% Respondents still receive DCW Services

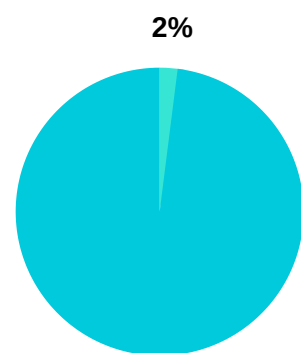


42% Respondents are unable to maintain a safe distance from their DCW

No Disruptions (55%)

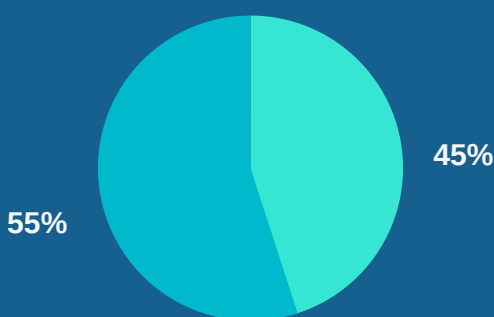


**Respondents who Take Medications**
