Dear Dr. Pérez-Stable:

On behalf of the Disability & Rehabilitation Research Coalition (DDRR), a coalition of 26 national research, clinical, and consumer non-profit organizations committed to improving the science of rehabilitation, disability, and independent living, we write to sincerely thank you for designating people with disabilities as a distinct health disparity population. This designation is a critical step in addressing health disparities faced by people with disabilities and ensuring their appropriate representation in research. We commend you and your colleagues for your leadership on advancing equity and inclusion through this important designation at the National Institutes of Health.

We also thank you for releasing the Notice of Funding Opportunity entitled "Health and Health Disparities Among Persons Living with Disabilities" to fund research examining the factors impacting the health and well-being of persons with disabilities at the intersections of race, ethnicity, and socioeconomic status. In addition, DRRC will be submitting a letter providing feedback on the proposed update to the NIH mission statement. We are grateful that the NIH is advancing these critical steps to addressing health equity for people with disabilities and look forward to future research initiatives and partnerships.
