Given the shift in health care delivery, there is a need for quality standards tailored to the unique challenges and opportunities presented by virtual and hybrid primary and urgent care organizations.

To address this need, we developed two evaluation modules designed for virtual primary care and virtual urgent care organizations. The program aims to create standardization, define and elevate best practices for a growing model of care delivery, address fragmentation, and assist organizations in their pursuit of quality care.


With future growth and adaptability in mind, NCQA will add additional modules to address other virtual care delivery domains over time.
